# **SUGGESTIONS ON HOW TO USE THE CARDS**

## **Flashcards**

To use the flashcards you should print out the picture pages and the word pages. These should then be put together back to back and laminated. Show the children one card at a time and they should call out the name of the animal. If you have a few children you are teaching I like to get them in two lines so they can compete against each other. It is also a great idea for the children to show each other the cards as the child holding the cards will see the name of the animal on the back and will learn that word quicker.

## **Word and picture match**

Print out one set of pictures and one set of words. If you like you can laminate them. Get the children to match which words match with which picture. This will also help the children to learn to spell the words.

## **Snap**

Print two copies of the words or pictures or both. Divide cards between children and then each lay one card down at a time. If your card matches with the one already on the pile you win all the cards in the pile. The winner is the one with the most cards at the end. You could also set a timer so the game doesn't go on for too long.

## **Memory Match**

Print out two copies each of the picture cards and then print the blank blue squares on page 9 eight times. These are the backs to the cards so the children cannot see the pictures through the cards.

To play the game lay all the cards on a table or the floor. Children take turns turning over the cards to find a pair. If you have fewer children you could use only half the cards.

I hope you have fun with these games. Remember this is just a suggestion for each game and you may not need to print out as many cards as you can mix and match the cards with each game.
